- 2) Only contractors or company divisions whose main activities are demolition, dismantling and decommissioning works may enter this award category.
- 3) The project must have started or ended between 1 July 2025 and 30 June 2026.
- 4) Entries must be in English. If you wish to enter in a different language, please contact neel.madsen@khl.com.
- 5) You CAN enter multiple awards.
- 6) You CAN submit more than one project within the same category.
- 7) BUT, the same project CANNOT be entered into more than one category.
- 8) If you are sending in more than one entry, please use a separate form for each one.
