The tone of your entry should reflect this. It should be written in plain English and avoid jargon, but please do not over-simplify or 'dumb-down' the content.

- **BE CERTAIN** that you have completed ALL sections of this form.

ENTRY RULES

- 1) All entries must be on an official pdf entry form.
- 2) Only contractors or company divisions whose main activities are demolition, dismantling and decommissioning works may enter this award category.
- 3) The project must have started or ended between 1 July 2023 and 30 June 2024.
- 4) Entries must be in English. If you wish to enter in a different language, please contact Leila.Steed@khl.com.
- 5) You CAN enter for more than one award.
- 6) You CAN enter more than one project in the same category.
- 7) You CANNOT enter the same project in more than one category.
- 8) If you are sending in more than one entry, please use a separate form for each one.
- 9) If including a client testimonial or other third-party material (statements/photos/video) in your submission, please include proof that they have given permission for these to be used by WDS and for possible print/online publication by D&Ri.
- 10) Award entries received after the 28 June deadline will NOT be accepted.
